What is the European Centre for Imaginary Art?

The European Centre for Imaginary Art launches its annual call for projects for its 24th International Exhibition of Sculptures and Plastic Installations in the Parc of Eben-Ezer's tower in Eben-Emael, Liège, Belgium, in cooperation with Interreg Meuse-Rhine.

Created in 1999, the centre pursues the objectives of opening up and promoting ART. Our goals:

- To bring together contemporary currents of artistic expression in the field of sculpture and plastic installations.
- Exhibit and promote artists from the European Union and more particularly from the Euregio Meuse-Rhine.
- Showcasing creation in the Eben-Ezer Park, where the natural element is an integral part of the creation.
- To be a forum for meetings and exchanges of art and ideas between artists, academics, artists' studios and artistic associations.

The first 23 exhibitions "Tell it to Alice, Dialogues of Art and the Tree, Man and Light, Metamorphoses, Firebirds, The Glade of the Centaurs, At the Gates of the Sun, Over Time, Earth Generations, A New World, Colors and Cultures , Fraternity!? In question, Aimé...! Resist! Between Doubt and Beauty, Living, Long Live Peace to Survive, Uniting Hopes, The Child Told Me, A New Encounter of the Enlightenment, Creating Now to Live Tomorrow, A New Youth to Life and Anchoring Peace... have welcomed more than 465,000 visitors since May 2000.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Launching in September

- 1. The CEAF is launching a call for projects to European artists, Academies and Institutes of Fine Arts as well as artists who have participated in previous exhibitions. (**Sculpture, painting, photography on canvas...**)
- 2.Applications will be received by 01.10.23 to 31.0 1.24 on presentation of the attached document. No applications will be accepted after this deadline.

Selection of works

- 3. The selection of exhibitors shall be made, from among all applications received, by a Selection Committee, 3 months before the start of the exhibition, **no later than 30 March 2024.**
- 4. The artist presents his work as widely as possible, through a written document, a visual (photos, drawing, sketches, etc.) justifying the intention of the creation for the use of the selection committee will be attached.
- 5. In addition, candidates will present references of previous experience.
- 6. The work installed must correspond to the project selected by the Selection Committee.
- 7. Any changes made will be considered as a new project that must be presented to the Selection Committee.

The organizing committee reserves the right to choose 3 additional works from the selection

Presentation, conservation and protection of works

- 8. The works shall be made available to the CEAF by the artists, for the duration of the exhibition, free of charge and may not be withdrawn before **15 June 2025**.
- 9.No commission shall be charged by the CEAF on the eventual sale of the works exhibited.
- 10. The works exhibited are covered by an insurance policy paid for by the CEAF for a maximum value of €10,000.
- 11. However, damages of less than €1,000 cannot be taken into account. Restauration costs will be borne by the organizers at the price of the materials used.

- 12. The works will be installed with maximum guarantee and safety (fixing to the ground, stability, guarantee against all external eventualities.)
- 13. The value to be insured for the works is determined under the responsibility of the policyholder of the insurance contract. Artists must therefore submit the value of the work they are exhibiting. This value must be determined by considering the cost of the materials used and the hours of work completed to complete the work.

In the event of damage or total loss, the amount compensated will be left to the discretion of the expert appointed by the insurer.

- 14. The CEAF shall not be liable for any failure to comply with these conditions.
- 15. An inventory of the work is established by agreement between the artist and the organizer.

Very important

- 16. The work presented must be described in its dimensions (height width depth weight).
- **Minimum height 100 cm**, please describe the quality of the materials used, degree of fragility and weather resistance as well as the anchoring method.

For any piece on a wooden base or support, the dimension is at least **120 cm high x 0.80 cm wide.** The base as well as the piece of art must be fixed in such a way as to be protected as much as possible. Oversized works are not insured.

17.The artwork will be designed with these elements in mind (the materials of the works will be chosen in such a way that they can remain outside for 1 year; works that do not meet the criteria described will not be selected)

Promotion

- 18. The C.E.A.F. covers all costs related to the promotion of the Exhibition (posters, folders, catalogue, radio and television programmes, press, etc.).

Duration of exposure

20. The exhibition runs for one year and is **installed outdoors** in the park of Eben-Ezer Tower in Eben-Emael. It will be set up at the end of June and closed in June of the following year. The dates of assembly and dismantling are set by the organizers.
